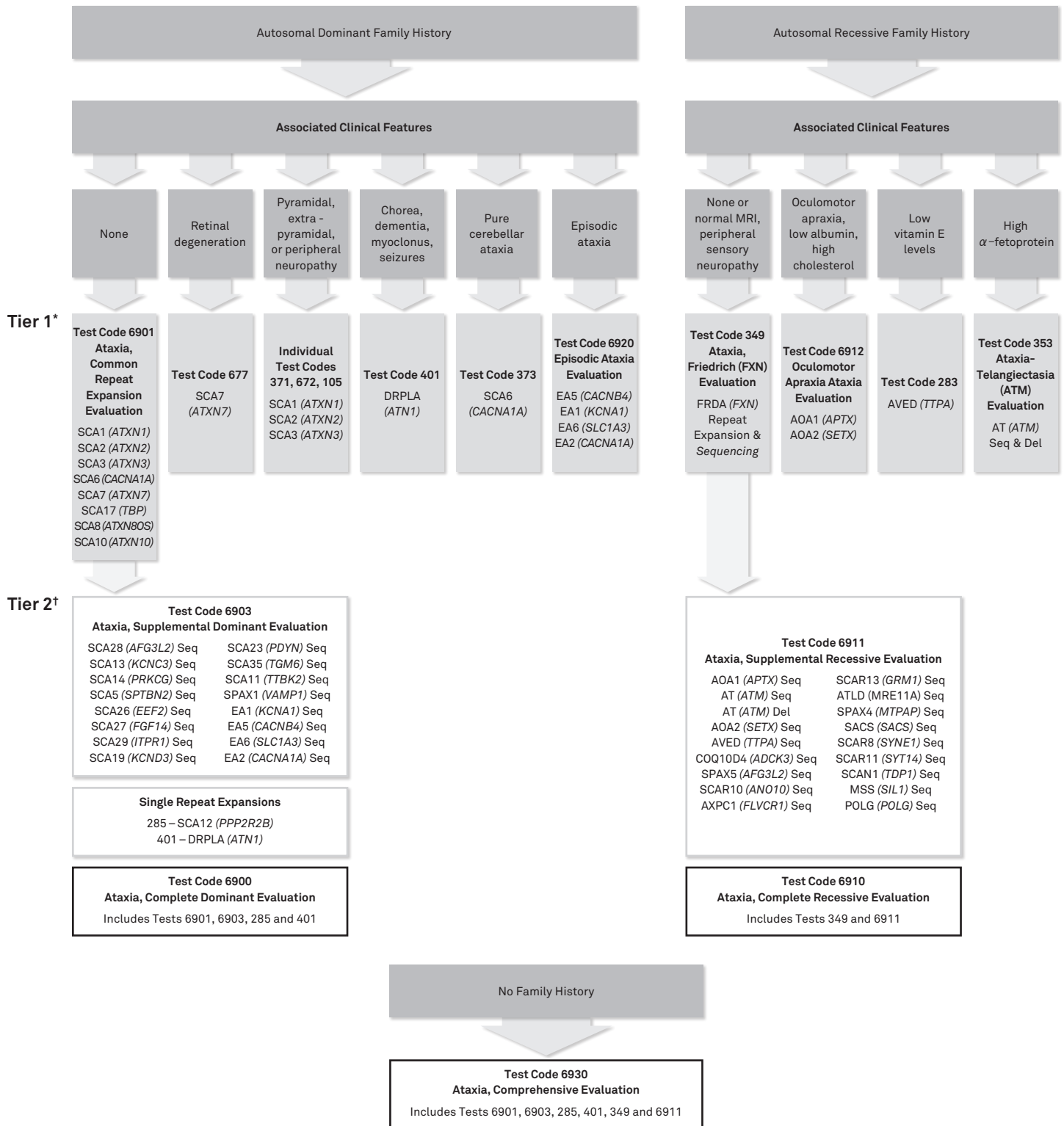


# Test Ordering Algorithm for Hereditary Ataxias
